## SEMINAR OUTLINE

### PART ONE:

In a quiet atmosphere conducive to writing, you will be led through a series of journal exercises which will enable you to gain new insights into the meaning and direction of your life. An important goal of the workshop is to explore who you most deeply are and what your life is trying to become. A notebook will be provided.

### PART TWO:

You will deepen your understanding of life experiences by working with dreams and images, events, and group connections, and through a unique form of meditation which uses the contents of your life as a resource for further experiences.

### PART THREE: \*

Now you have glimpsed the meaning and direction of your life from multiple vantage points, it is time to put it all together, to sense larger integrations that have been taking place, and to use your rich inner resources to step more purposefully into the future.

Maureen McCormack, S.L., Ph.D., is a Sister of Loretto and a psychologist residing in Denver. She served as president of the Loretto Community for eight years and has been giving journal workshops throughout the United States for over 25 years. She pioneered a journal program for inmates in the U.S. prison system and, in recognition, received an award from the Institute of Women Today.
